GP/ Pharmacist Information

Home Medicines Review (HMR)

Also known as Domiciliary Medication Management Review DMMR

➤ Identify patient for HMR

- Can be done by any member of the health care team, patient or carer



➤ GP initiates and refers to community pharmacy

- GP decides if patient may benefit, using the risk factors and
- obtains patient consent for the process and the exchange of information,
- Sends an HMR Referral to community pharmacy of the patient's choice



➤ Pharmacist conducts patient interview

- Preferred place is the patient's home, but venue is the patient's choice
- Can be conducted by community pharmacists or accredited pharmacist



➤ Pharmacist conducts Medication Management Review

- Must be conducted by an accredited pharmacist
- Using all the available information such as the patient interview, the information from the GP and the dispensed medication history



➤ Pharmacist reports to GP

- Verbal and written HMR report



➤ GP Medication Management Plan for patient

- Prepared by GP in consultation with the patient, can lead to a new GP Management Plan or Team Care Arrangement



➤ GP sends Medication Management Plan to pharmacy

- And offers a copy to the patient



➤ GP claims Item 900
